

1. Bush Gully: 1897-1901 A large sheep station on the Martinborough Pahaoa Road past the Hinakura school site about 30 kilometres from Martinborough. School



25th February 1891 Mr. W. McLaren made application for an aided school at Bush Gully near Martinborough. The usual grant of £3 15s per head upon results was made. It does not appear that this school opened with state funding until 1897

On the 5th October 1892 J J Guest, teacher was listed as being at Bush Gully when he won an art competition. Presumably he was teaching there

J J Guest was at Brancepath School in 1895 and 1896 and then went to Te Ore Ore School and Te One School in Chatham Islands

5th June 1897 WANTED, a Governess salary £35 to 40 . Apply for particulars to Secretary Education Board, or direct to Mrs. McLaren, Bush Grove Martinborough, Wairarapa

25th August 1897 The appointment of Miss Mason as teacher at the Bush Gully School was approved
