16<sup>th</sup> December 1899 At Carlton Hill Gladstone, may be observed on a side cutting leading into Mr Miller's homestead a layer of yellow clay immediately below the limestone formation. Mr Dalrymple and a friend passing along that road on Saturday last noticed peculiar marks in the clay and enquiring the cause, ascertained that the marks were made by the teeth of the sheep, who were, seen licking and scraping the clay. The visitors detached some of the clay and tasted it when they found it to be strongly impregnated with salt. PP
