

Kaiwaka: 1910-1914 Ross Family The Kaiwaka School was on the Road to Cape Palliser Lighthouse from Pirinoa. 57 Kilometres from Martinborough



Cornelius O'Leary went on to teach at Waihoki Valley out of Pongaroa and then Awatoitoi. he spent over a year in Masterton hospital and died after falling out of a hotel bed in Wellington
6th April 1910 Kaiwaka(Martinborough) Sole Teacher, probable salary £90 to £120

28th February 1911. Mrs R Murray Resigned from Kaiwaka

14th March 1911 Kaiwaka (Near Featherston) Sole Teacher; £90 to £120, and £10 housing allowance (*This meant that Featherston was the nearest railway station not necessarily close to*)

29th March 2011 During 1910 there were opened new schools at Waihoki, Akitio, Kaiwaka, Pencarrow, Putara, and Pakowai

11th April 1911 Kaiwaka School Mr. K. McKenzie (sole teacher)

31st July 1912 Mr. J C. McKenzie, Kaiwaka Resigned

29th March 1916 Schools were closed at. Mikimiki Valley, Waimanu,. Wangaehu, Pori, Kaiwaka, and Aohanga,
