1908-1935 Yet another small school in the Akitio County. Located 6 Kilometres from Pongaroa coming South on State Highway 52. From Opening to at least 1923 Irene Hamilton was the only teacher at this school

4th March 1929 Miss J W Peters ST Kohiku

17th May 1933 Wellington Education Board Miss B A McGreevy appointed

23rd December 1935 Erection of Bridge in Reinforced Concrete, 30ft span, and formation of approaches, Kohiku, Masterton-Weber M.H., 4 miles from Pongaroa.

[I have never had a school which as so few references on Papers Past. The school must have been an aided school until the 1920's. I can find no references to an Irene E Hamilton living in New Zealand]
