Mangapari: 1915 Mr A D McLeod's farm South of Martinborough Roll of 3 on White Rock Road 14 Kilometers from Martinborough

10th February 1892 A strange kind of fish has been caught at Napier, It appears to be allied to the shark tribe, and has what seems to be two short legs near the fins on the underside, with a proboscis like a flipper with which to supply the mouth with food. The Natives call it a Mangapari,"

27th April 1917 WANTED, Governess, to teach 2 boys, aged 7 and 10 years. Apply, stating previous experience, and salary required, to Mrs. A. D. McLeod, Mangapari Station, Martinborough

1923 Mr Alex McLeod was an MP
