1st September 1886 FOR SALE.—Choice Business Sites and allotments' up to 5 acres in the rising township of Eketahuna. Also sections at Mauriceville Station, from ¼ to 7 acres. RAWSON & MAOKAY

1st October 1886 The surveys of land for village settlements in Mauriceville and Woodville are steadily proceeding, and the land will be thrown open to the public in a month or so. The areas will vary in size from 10 to 30 acres

22nd July Masterton School Correspondence was read from the Education Board, stating that the Board had agreed to appoint Mr Willis to the new' school at Mauriceville and that temporary assistance would be sent to the Masterton school if required

24th August 1887 The new school near the Mauriceville Railway Station was opened this week with an attendance of fifty children

22nd December 1887 The telegraph extension party under the charge of Mr Louisson had the wire completed as far as Mauriceville Railway Station this forenoon
