The teachers are recorded as above when the school is open at the end of the school year. So sometimes the Momona School was open for part of the year but the teachers didn't stay to finish the year.

31<sup>st</sup> January 1901 Teacher's salary E Speedy paid £7 10s per year recommended salary increase £2 10s

31<sup>st</sup> March 1901 Another proposed scale Momona (aided) Attendance 3 Sole Teacher Proposed £15 increase £3 15s [Aided meant the Wellington Education Board paid a per head figure and all other costs were met locally]

26<sup>th</sup> March 1902 This school is now closed as the teacher has left. Inspector's report 26<sup>th</sup>

11<sup>th</sup> March 1905 Wellington Education Board advertised for a teacher for Momona Aided School £35 and Board

22<sup>nd</sup> March 1907 Momona School was closed during 1906

Robina Harvey taught at Waterfalls [Name changed to Tiraumea later as there was a Waterfalls School in Marlborough. The Marlborough Education Board joined Wellington Education Board in 1915]

A Mrs Ethel Miller taught at Johnsonville school in 1906
