

**Pahaoa** 1891-1892, 1896-1897. Spelt Pahau in Wellington Education Board parlance. Pahaoa is 45 Kilometres from Martinborough on the Hinakura Road then Pahaoa Road.

26<sup>th</sup> August 1896 The customary capitation grant of £3 15s per head per annum was made to aided schools at Ngakomi and Pahaua

31<sup>st</sup> August 1901 Take again the case of the erection of the Pahaua and Mangapakeha schoolhouses substantial, fully equipped buildings, erected two years ago or more one of which has never been used, and the other only for short periods of time. Once more, we have the ill-advised purchase of useless sites at Tockers Corner, Akatarawa, and Weraroa, and yet again the selection of precipitous lands at Brooklyn and Mitchelltown, which have proved an endless expense for excavation and formation, and
