

Papatahi

Papatahi: 1913-1914 Wairongomai School started in 1915. On Western Lake Road close to the Wairongomai School on Papatahi Road.. Papatahi is a farm long in the Donald Family, now known for their Hereford Cattle . 28 Kilometres south of Featherston following Western Lake Road

Papatahi School was renamed Wairongomai School in 1915. It was not in the same building as the Wairongomai School Building

29th July 1914 The Papatahi School Committee forwarded a plan of the new schools building, and made application for furniture and other assistance from the board.— The matter was referred to the inspector, who will be visiting the district shortly

23rd December 1914 Papatahi, sole teacher, Miss M. H. Weitzel

27th January 1915 A change of name was agreed upon by the Wellington Education Board yesterday. The change suggested and decided upon was the alteration of filename of a school site near the Wairarapa lake from Papatahi to Wairongomai.
