1911-1915 36 Kilometres from Pahiatua along the Pahiatua Pongaroa road then onto the Pori Road. [Some of the Posts in Newspaper Past refer to it as Pori Alfredton. This school could well have been put in the Eketahuna Schools instead of Pahiatua Saunders Road was close by Toss of coin material]

26th March 1912 Wellington Education Board acknowledges opening of Pori School in 1911

20th June 1913 An effort is being made to establish a party telephone line between Pahiatua and Pori. The distance is twenty-four miles

12th August 1913 As the matter will come before the meeting of the Board to-morrow, no action was taken. Messrs A Nelson, P. G. Wilton, J. Clulow and F.- Hillas, of Pori, petitioned the Pahiatua County Council on Saturday to make a readjustment with the Masterton County Council of county boundaries.

8th October 1913 he Pori; settlers are erecting a party, telephone line between Pori arid Pahiatua, a distance v of 14 miles

12th December 1913 Miss Storrier's resignation accepted by Wellington Education Board

14th January 1914 Advertisement in the Dominion Newspaper Wanted Governess for country' One that has worked under Education Board preferred. Mrs A Nelson Pori, Alfredton

29th July 1914 Resignation of Miss M B Gibb accepted. [Was still teaching at Pori at the end of 1914
