

Taipoa

Taipoa: 1888 An aided school 26 Kilometres on the Te Mai Road from Tinui. Taipoa was a sheep station. This station backed onto Mataikona Station and Whakataki Station

25th April 1888 The appointment of Mr. J J Guest to the charge of the aided school at Taipoa was approved

There is only the one mention of a school at Taipoa in teacher's records but I guess that this school was run as a private school except in 1888

Joseph Guest went onto to teach at Brancepath in 1895, then Te Ore Ore state school before going to the Chatham Islands for a while in 1905. He finished his teaching career in Te Teko, near Whakatane while teaching near Frasertown, Wairoa on his return from the Chathams
