27th May 1904 Annual report of the inspector included Aided schools ore established at Admiral Run, Bush Grove, Ngakonui, Tikaramonga and Toro. [An aided school was where the community provided a premise and a teacher and the Education Board provided a set sum of money on a per head bases]

1st September 1905 Wellington Education Board to pay rent for school building

26th October 1906 Applications for establishment of schools' or increased accommodation were received from Crofton, Toro, end Johnsonville. —Referred to the inspector

Christina Morriss wasn't registered in BDM under this name. She was registered only in 1900 only as an elector.
