4th October 1921 Heading work of disabled included Trentham Hospital has now many child patients, crippled by infantile ailments, for whom the expert staff is doing much to alleviate suffering. For the children there are special classes for their work in the hospital school.

6th May 1922 The following letter has been received by the general secretary of the .N.'Z.R:S.A. in acknowledgment :of a wreath of Flanders poppies forwarded on Anzac Pay to the paralysed school children at Trentham:—"We children of .Trentham Hospital. School wish to thank you very much for your wreath of remembrance which you sent to us for Anzac Day. It is now hanging on the wall of our schoolroom, where we can all see it, and it will always remind us of the heroes who fought for us." The. letter was. signed by 66 pupil patients

In 1923 **Miss E M Hooper** was teaching at Hutt DHS

I can find no other reference to this school which was only open a short time. The Wellington Education Board had kept no records of the school but as the teachers were listed in their records they must have been responsible for paying staff

Jessie Seed was teaching as a pupil teacher at Hutt DHS with King's Road side school in 1914. Went to Training College around 1917 She was in 1919 at the Newtown School
