6th January 1891 WANTED, a Governess, for the country ; must be a good music teacher .
Apply to Mrs. H. Fraser, Waikawa, Manakau.

28th January 1891 Wellington Education Board Accepted the resignation of Miss Boylan of the Waikawa School. And appointed Miss Duncan in her place.

30th March 1892 Wellington Education Board Annual report stated the Waikawa School had been closed.

Nellie Boylan only taught for Wellington Education Board at Waikawa

22nd March 1907 Wellington Education Board Notifying that a school had been opened at Waimanu.

Laura Christie taught at Pencarrow School in 1905 [At the lighthouse] and Waimanu in 1907

Amelia M Whitaker, Eileen Rankin, Eva Ester, Mabel Norwood, only taught for the Wellington Education Board at Waimanu

Vera I Curtis was a pupil teacher at Petone DHS from 1909 to 1911 1912 and 1913 she was at Waimanu. Then from 1917 to at least 1921 was Ihuarau Valley [Known by locals as Ishurau] aka Ihuarau School 37 miles North East of Masterton then by 1923 was a reliever at Lansdowne School in Masterton

34th August 1925 Evening Post IF Vera Curtis communicates with 917, Evg. Post, she will hear of something to her advantage." Anybody knowing whereabouts please advise.

16th October 1926 Miss Vera Curtis, of the Masterton Central School staff, who is now in Canada on the exchange system, has commenced duty at the Grace Street School, Toronto

18th April 1938 Miss Vera Curtis, of New Plymouth, and formerly of Taonui School, is spending Easter in Feilding.

12th May 1942 Miss Vera Curtis, headmistress of the Mangorei School, [East of New Plymouth] has arrived at Wellington to attend a meeting of the executive of the New Zealand Educational Institute.
