7<sup>th</sup> March 1877 One Clark Rampling, who styled himself an Architect and Builder, was fined 10s and costs, with 24 hours alternative, at the R.M. Court on Monday, for being in a condition in which an architect certainly should not be. 4<sup>th</sup> March 1909 A telegram received yesterday by Inspector Ellison states that an old age pensioner, named Clarke Rampling died suddenly at Manakau yesterday morning. The coroner does not consider an inquest necessary.
